<u>Presentation by Future Analytics Consulting Ltd. on Dublin Regional Enterprise Strategy</u>

A wide discussion took place during which Dearbhla Lawson and Georgina Sweetnam responded to questions and comments from SPC members.

Dearbhla Lawson asked for an action to include reference to 'promotion of the growth and investment opportunities within the Strategic Development Zones in the Region', and suggested amendments to include reference to the Sandyford Business District in the document

Subject to the above amendments being included, the members of the SPC **approved** the Strategy. It was proposed by the Chairperson and all agreed to refer the Dublin Regional Enterprise Strategy to the January meeting of the County Council for **Noting** with the approval of the SPC
