The **Local Authority Waters Programme (LAWPRO)** invite you to a public consultation meeting on the **Draft River Basin Management Plan for Ireland 2022-2027**.

Darragh O'Brien, Minister for Housing, Local Government, and Heritage, and Malcolm Noonan, Minister of State for Heritage at DHLGH published the draft plan on 27th Sept. 2021 for a six-month public consultation, closing 31st March 2022.

LAWPRO, as a local authority shared service is supporting the Department with the draft plan by delivering local level engagement and hosting public consultation meetings online.
