

SECTION 14 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 THE PRESERVATION OF AN EXISTING PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY MARINO AVENUE WEST, KILLINEY, COUNTY DUBLIN TO BE INCLUDED IN THE COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2022 -2028

On 15th February 2021, notice was served under section 14 (1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 on owners and occupiers of land over which a public right of way at Marino Avenue West, Killiney, County Dublin exists, that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council proposed to include a provision relating to the preservation of this existing public right of way in the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Development Plan 2022 -2028.

The said owners and occupiers were invited to make submissions or observations on the the proposal on or before Friday 16th April 2021.

Notice is given that the Council of the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown, being the Planning Authority for the County has, pursuant to Section 14 (3) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 considered the proposal to preserve the existing public right of way as set out above and any submissions or observations made in respect of this proposal and has recommended the inclusion of a provision relating to the preservation of the public right of way at Marino Avenue West, Killiney, County Dublin in the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Development Plan 2022 -2028.

The Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Development Plan 2022 -2028 was made by resolution at a meeting of the Council on 10th March 2022. The extent of the public right way being preserved can be viewed on the dlr website [www.dlrcoco.ie] or at the Planning Counter in the Council's offices at Marine Road, Dun Laoghaire, County Dublin.

Under Section 14 (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 any person who has been notified of the recommendation of the planning authority in relation to the preservation of the above public right of way in the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Development Plan 2022 -2028 may, before the expiration of 21 days following the notification, appeal to the Circuit Court against the inclusion in the development plan of the proposed provision, and the Court, if satisfied that no public right of way exists, shall so declare and the provision shall accordingly not be included in the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Development Plan 2022 -2028.
