## Stakeholder and Public Consultation Meeting

## On Tuesday January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 (4pm-8pm)

Dublin City Council, Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and the Office of Public Works are hosting a stakeholder and public consultation meeting to obtain views and other important information in relation to flooding on the River Dodder. The area of interest extends from Clonskeagh Road Bridge to Orwell Road bridge (in addition Little Dargle Stream at Braemor Road-Woodside Drive south-eastern junction) and includes flooding arising from river and storm water drains.

Relevant stakeholders and members of the public are invited to attend to make their views known and to discuss issues. The design team (ByrneLooby) will be on hand along with relevant members of Dublin City Council, Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and the Office of Public Works. All comments received will be considered in the development of possible flood mitigation measures.
