

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADDITION TO THE RECORD OF PROTECTED STRUCTURES IN THE DÚN LAOGHAIRE-RATHDOWN COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2022-2028

SECTIONS 54 AND 55 OF THE PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED)

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Sections 54 and 55 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council proposes the following addition to the Record of Protected Structures (RPS) in the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Development Plan 2022-2028:

Red Brick (former) Chapel (exterior only), located along Tivoli Terrace South, to the rear
of Centenary House, 35 York Road, Dún Laoghaire.

This proposed addition to the RPS is not on foot of a Ministerial recommendation.

The particulars of the above proposed addition to the Record of Protected Structures, along with the reports to inform screening for Appropriate Assessment and Strategic Environmental Assessment and associated determinations, in accordance with the Planning And Development Regulations, 2001 (as amended) Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations (S.I. 436 of 2004, as amended) and the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC (as amended), will be available for inspection for a period of 6 weeks from Tuesday 13th September 2022 to Wednesday 26th October 2022 at the following locations:
